2017 ELECTION NOTICE

October 27, 2017

1. The election of Local 2366 officers will be conducted at the following locations:

- *Carrizo Springs Station*; December 06, 2017; 5- 9 a.m. & 1 - 5 p.m.
- *Eagle Pass North Station*; December 06, 2017; 5 – 9 a.m. & 1 – 5 p.m.
- *Eagle Pass South Station*; December 06, 2017; 5 – 9 a.m. & 1 – 5 p.m.
- *Uvalde Station*; December 07, 2017; 5 - 9 a.m. & 1 - 5 p.m.
- *Brackettville Station*; December 07, 2017; 5 – 9 a.m. & 1 – 5 p.m.
- *Local 2366 Union Office*; December 07, 2017; 5 – 9 a.m. & 1 – 5 p.m.

2. Offices to be filled by election are: Southern Corridor Vice-President and Treasurer.

3. Qualifications for office are: be a member in good standing of this local; be a member for one year of an AFGE local, immediately preceding the closing of the nomination process; not be a member in any labor organization not affiliated with the AFL-CIO; and candidates shall not run for more than one office in the same local election.

4. The upcoming term of office is three (3) years, ending with the installation of officers following the regularly scheduled elections on **September 2020**. Installation during the December 2017 meeting will follow the conclusion of the election.

5. Any member who has paid dues through the scheduled voting days or any member who has signed a dues withholding form (SF-1187) accepted by a responsible officer of the local, is in good standing, and eligible to vote. Members will be asked to present a Local 2366 membership card, driver's license, or some other form of **picture identification** at the polls. A picture identification is mandatory.

6. Written requests for an absentee ballot should be directed to AFGE District 10 National Representative, Deborah L. Leach at LeachD@afge.org, to be received by the election committee at least one week prior to the commencement of voting. Requests received later will be honored; however, there is no guarantee that those ballots will be returned in time to be counted. Absentee ballots must be received in **P.O. Box 421316, Del Rio, Texas 78842 by 5:30 p.m. on December 07, 2017.**

7. Each candidate may have one observer, who is a member, present throughout the election process, including the tally of ballots.

8. All protests to the election must be in writing and received by AFGE District 10 National Representative, Deborah L. Leach at LeachD@afge.org, prior to, during, or within **ten** days after the election. This election is governed by the AFGE Rules of Conduct for an Election, set forth in Appendix A of the AFGE National Constitution.
