

AFGE Local 2366 – 2017 SECRET MAIL BALLOT ELECTION NOTICE
Tallying of Votes: December 14, 2017 at 11:00 A.M.

1. The election of Local 2366 officers and delegates shall be conducted by Secret Mail Ballots, to be tallied on December 14, 2017, starting at approximately 11:00 a.m. until completion, at the Local 2366 Union Hall, 801 Kings Way, Del Rio, TX 78840.
2. Offices to be filled in this election are: **Southern Corridor Vice-President** and **Treasurer**. Qualifications for office are: be a member in good standing of this local; be a member for one year of an AFGE local, immediately preceding the closing of the nomination process; not be a member in any labor organization not affiliated with the AFL-CIO; and shall not run for more than one office in the same local election.
3. The term of office is two (2) years, ending with the installation of officers after regularly scheduled elections in **September 2019**. No runoff election shall be necessary, because only two candidates have been nominated per office. The candidate who receives the majority of votes cast for each office, shall be declared elected.
4. Any member, who is current on their dues payments through December 14, 2017, and/or has signed dues withholding form (SF 1187) accepted by a responsible officer of the local, will be eligible to vote.
5. The Secret Mail Ballot package, which provides for ballot secrecy using a double envelope system, will be mailed to each member at the last known home address on or about November 27, 2017. Each member should timely return (by mail) the ballot in the self-addressed and stamped envelope provided. If you do not receive a ballot, email AFGE District 10 National Representative, Deborah L. 6. **PLEASE DO NOT FORGET TO WRITE YOUR RETURN ADDRESS ON THE ENVELOPE for your vote to be counted. The deadline for receipt of your ballot in the designated P.O. Box is no later than December 14, 2017 at 10:00 A.M.**¹
7. Each candidate may have one observer, **who is a member**, present throughout the election process, including the tally of ballots.² All protests to the election must be in writing and received by Deborah L. Leach, at leachd@afge.org prior to, during, or within ten (10) days after the election. This 2017 election is governed by the AFGE Rules of Conduct for an Election, set forth in Appendix A of the AFGE National Constitution.

¹Candidates and observers shall be permitted to witness the Election Committee's opening of P.O. Box 421997, and the placing and locking of the mailed ballots in the ballot box, on December 14, 2017 at 10:00 A.M., at the U.S. Post Office, 2001 N. Bedell Ave., Del Rio, TX 78840.

²Candidates and observer shall also be permitted to witness the Election Committee's opening of P.O. Box 421316 on December 5, 2017 at 3:00 P.M. (at the same Post Office), and the retrieval of returned ballots with bad addresses. Every effort shall be made to correct the bad address and resend the Secret Mail Ballot package ASAP.
