

In computing the weekly average of overtime worked by the employee, the Department of Justice provides that certain days can be excluded from the computation in units of a full day. These excludable days are as follows:

EXCLUDABLE DAYS

- HOLIDAYS
- TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENTS OF 10+ CONSECUTIVE DAYS WHEN AUO IS DISCONTINUED
- PAID LEAVE
- TRAINING PERIODS WHEN AUO WAS NOT PERFORMED

There are also periods of time that are included in the computation, including the following:

NOT EXCLUDABLE DAYS

- HOLIDAYS FOR WHICH HOLIDAY PAY IS RECEIVED
- LEAVE FOR LESS THAN A FULL DAY
- THE FIRST 10 DAYS ON TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT TO NON-AUO DUTIES
